
## Star 5



## How to make star 5

This star is made using the Foundation Paper Piecing method, which is not only very easy but incredibly accurate. Watch the video for the 12 Days of Christmas Day 5.

Cut 6 pieces, 7½" x 4" from the light fabric A (cut 3 pairs, right sides together) Templates: B1, B3, C1, C3, D1, D3.

Cut 1 piece 8" x 8" from the medium fabric B Template: A1

Cut 6 pieces 4½" x 4½" from the dark fabric C Templates: A2, A3, A4, B2, C2, D2.

Cut out the templates provided. You will need to tape some pieces together because we use them for sewing the star together.

## Notes:

- There will be waste fabric from all these cuts, but if you are nervous or unfamiliar with FPP this is the easiest method.
- I have, for this star and star 6, added photos to help you.
- This is just a guide and not my normal full pattern.
- My video will be there for you to watch at all times.



Fold all the templates along the solid lines



Place fabric right side down, trim to ¼" from the fold of template.



Place one dark square right side up and line up with trim line.



Fold back the paper and sew along the solid line.



Sew all 3 triangles, flip over and trim to the outer dashed line.



Trimmed, do not remove the paper. Press well.

Continue sewing all the remaining shapes following this method. Use the numbers on the templates to guide you with the order of sewing together. Watch the video!







Once all 4 templates have been stitched, sew them together in this order.
