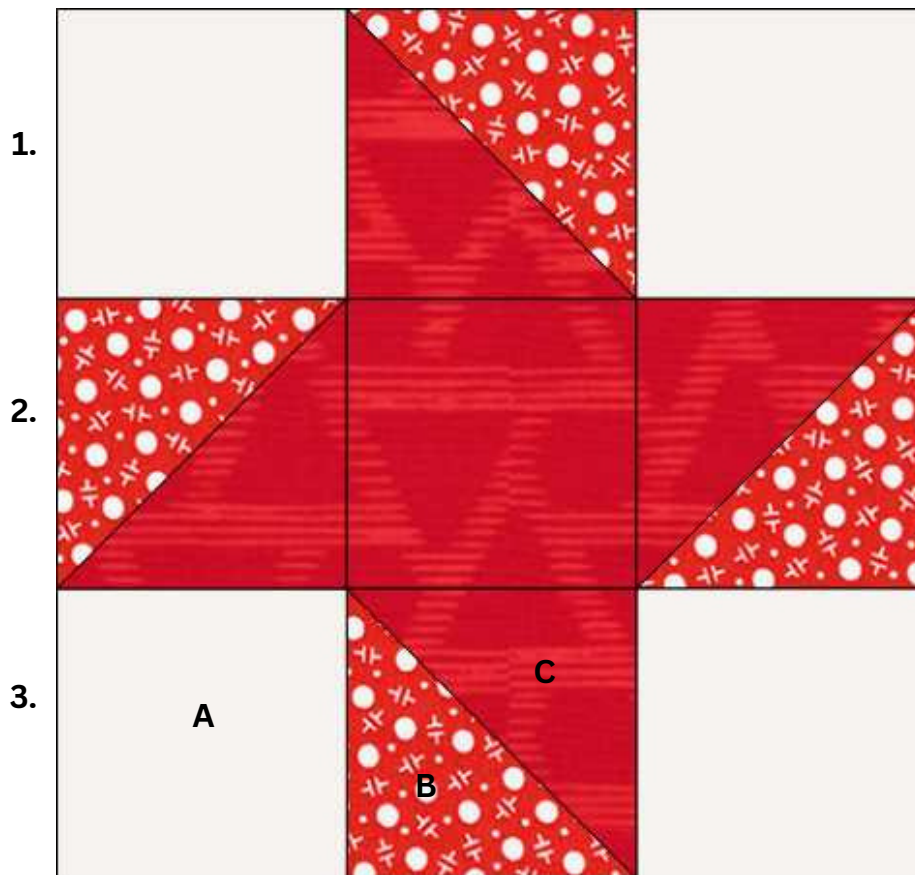


Star 2



How to make star 2

Cut 4 ($4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$) from the lighter colour, A.

Cut 1 ($4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$) from the dark colour, C.

Cut 2 ($5'' \times 5''$) from the medium colour, B.

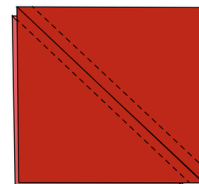
Cut 2 ($5'' \times 5''$) from the dark colour, C.

Place 1 dark $5'' \times 5''$ square right sides together with 1 medium $5'' \times 5''$ square.

Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner.

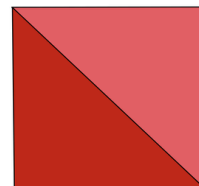
Sew either side of that line $\frac{1}{4}''$ seam allowance.

Cut on your drawn line.



Open up and press well.

Repeat for the other 2 ($5'' \times 5''$) squares.



Trim (HST) squares to measure $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$. You will have 4.

Now sew together the squares to form row 1, then 2, then 3, by following the pattern above.

Now sew the rows together.
